Communication, Language and Literacy:

Name recognition...you can support your child at home to first recognise and then begin to mark-make their names. You could write the letters of their name on Duplo blocks or post it notes, use magnetic letters or anything that can be jumbled up. Provide them with an example of their written name and encourage them to put the letters in the correct order.

Label things with their name at home, providing lots of opportunities to see their name in print.

As you write your child's name say the phonic sounds and talk about how you are forming the letters as you write them.

Woodland Wonder

As this week is due to be wet, you may find these snails in the grassy vegetation alongside the path by Mickleham playground.

Roman snails are large, edible, land-breathing snails, and are easily spotted by their size and their striped pattern shell.
