Dear parents and carers,

This week at nursery we will continue with Mini Beasts. We will think about how certain mini beasts move and copy them. We will have resources to create dens or mini beast homes and use these for role play. We have name writing cards for our older children to practice writing their names and lacing boards for all children to continue developing their pencil grip. Children will also be busy creating a gift for Father's/Grandfather's day.


#### Communication, Language & Literacy:
