Several children made bird feeders in Forest School last week, so this week we will have the resources available for all children to make these. If you have any pine cones at home, our stocks are low and would benefit from replenishment! Thank you.

Keeping the birds theme and current interest going, we will have birds in playdough, alongside dinosaur skeletons, and birds for small-world play too. There has also been interest in volcanoes, so we have bought some ingredients for creating volcanic eruptions! We will also have the glue table for gluing and sticking, some children will choose to make things from junk to bring home, and others will just enjoy the experience of runny glue. This is a great activity and we usually have it available for several weeks at a time which allows children to keep building on previous work.
